May 25: Last Day of School/ Early Dismissal at 1:10pm

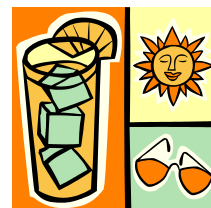
NOTES FROM MS. MALLOY AND MS. AL KHULI
